**REASON** The reason for this notice is to allow any members of the public to review and comment on the discretionary use development permit application prior to Council making a decision.



### Re: Certified Operation and Maintenance Monthly Fee

SaskWater has re-evaluated its Certified Operation and Maintenance (COM) service to be more customer focused. As part of the evaluation, we have made two changes to our rate review process.

First, all COM customers will move to a January 1<sup>st</sup> rate adjustment implementation date, which lines up with customers' financial year. Secondly, SaskWater will be transitioning to a longer notice period for rate adjustments. Starting in 2022, all COM customers will receive six (6) months' notice on rate adjustments. Therefore, in 2022, you will receive notice in early July of adjustments to your rate for 2023.

Joan, you can make application for an AHPP for this project, we issue a number of these permits to RMs, Resort Villages and Regional Park. This is the information from the 1995 Fish Habitat Guidelines for community beaches which we still follow:

- Large-scale recreational developments will be allowed to develop community beaches of suitable size within a
  reasonable distance of the development, provided that critical fish habitat is not affected. Community beaches
  should be restricted to less than 50 metres of shoreline.
- Removal of aquatic vegetation and rocks may be allowed at community beaches to a lakeward depth of two
  metres. Depth is measured in relation to the high-water line but exceptions are possible in extreme low water
  situations.
- Sand may be deposited at community beaches in the foreshore area and in water to a lakeward depth of two
  metres. Sand and gravel used in beach development should be free of silt and clay. If sand is deposited during
  the winter, the area should be flagged beforehand to indicate approved areas.
